The Youth Philanthropy Council is pleased to announce the grant cycle for the second semester of the 2023-2024 school year. Below is a QR code that can take you to the live application. You may also ask any Youth Philanthropy Council member for assistance or request to be sent a link.

The mission of the YPC is to empower White County youth by cultivating philanthropic engagement and leadership.

History: The Youth Philanthropy Council was formed under the umbrella of the Community Foundation of White County, whose mission is to strengthen and transform White County by fostering charitable giving, philanthropic aspiration, and leadership. Since our inception 25 years ago, over \$5 million has been granted to support efforts in the White County community. To expand our impact with youth, a regional cultivation grant from Wabash Heartland Innovative Network has fully funded this program for its first two years.

The Youth Philanthropy Council was formed in January of 2023 and has already awarded 33 grants among all four county school corporations. There is still much for the council to learn, and we would love any and all feedback to make this an easy process for our partners and applicants.

Eligibility: Grants are made to educators and staff who have ideas for innovative projects or supplies for which funding is not readily available through the regular school corporation's financial sources. Only programs within any of White County's four school corporations will be eligible for grant funding. The Council is particularly interested in programs that:

1. Demonstrate unique and effective ways to meet students' needs
2. Enhance student achievement
3. Promote mental wellness among students
4. Offer new forms of engagement
5. Increase motivation to learn.

Ineligibility: The Community Foundation of White County does not accept requests for:

1. previously incurred debts
2. political campaigns
3. religious purposes
